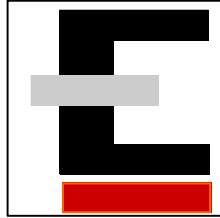


The Energy Regulation Board was established by the Energy Regulation Act, Cap 436 of the Laws of Zambia.
